A parish prayer

At this time of the year, we have a heightened awareness of the beauty of sunlit mornings, the setting of the evening sun, the profound stillness and peace of our Church and the sheer awe of the glory of creation.

Go out and stand on the mountain before the Lord, for the Lord is about to pass by .

(1 Kings verse 11)

We read this verse when we celebrate the Transfiguration of Our Lord on 6th August. Elijah's experience of Jesus revealed in dazzling glory was breath taking in its gentleness. We find God in quiet places, in the smile of a child or the shape of a leaf, as well as in spectacular events.

On the same day we lament the Hiroshima atomic bomb, but Elijah's experience encourages us to look for God in quiet encounters on mountains rather than in spectacular displays of power. Let us recognise Presence, not summon fire.
